Nagoya University of Foreign Studies Activity Guidelines (from May 12)

In accordance with the response of the Aichi Prefectural Government to the novel coron avirus, Nagoya University of Foreign Studies (NUFS) has established a set of activity guidelines. In principle, the levels will be reviewed on a regular basis. In the near future, we will conduct a fundamental review of the activity guidelines, taking into a ccount the strengthening of infection prevention measures at the university and the st atus of new coronavirus infections.

	Levels	From March 1
1. Lectures/Classes	Level 2	In order to prevent infection, face-to-face clas ses in the classroom and online classes will be used together. (Students will be asked to come e very other week in order to avoid the 3 Cs in th e classroom) In exceptional cases, full face-to-face classes or full online classes may be acceptable dependi ng on the class subject.
2. Faculty / Research Act ivities	Level 1	Continue research activities with infection cont rol measures (recommend research activities at h ome).
3.Office Administration	Level 1	Work as usual, taking care to prevent the spread of infection. Work from home depending on the n ature of the work.
4. Meetings	Level 1	Continue online meetings in principle. Face-to-f ace meetings are possible with infection prevent ion measures, if necessary.
5. Student campus access	Level 1	Partial relaxation of campus entry restrictions. Permission to enter the campus for the purpose o f taking designated classes, online classes, usi ng the library/access points, and self-study aft er taking infection prevention measures (notific ation required).
6. Extracurricular activi ties	Level 2	No indoor gatherings on or off campus. Some extracurricular activities are allowed depe nding on the activity status.

General Level Guidelines

Level 0: When the risk of infection is significantly reduced.

Level 1: Although there is a risk of infection, the request to refrain from traveling in daily life has been lifted and adequate measures have been taken to prevent infecti

on. Therefore, it has been determined that students are able to live a near-normal uni versity life.

Level 2: Although there is a risk of infection and a state of emergency has been decla red by the national and prefectural governments, the university has not been asked to suspend activities.

Level 3: Due to the declaration of a state of emergency or a cluster outbreak of infec ted persons on campus, a request to suspend university activities has been issued.

Guidelines for each level

1. Lectures and Classes

Level 0	Lectures as usual
Level 1	 Lecture in the classroom with infection control measures For classes that are difficult to take adequate infection control measures, online cla sses will be offered As an infection prevention measure, students can attend lectures on-campus or from hom e using an on-campus computer or their own computer (It is at the discretion of each lecturer to decide which style of lecture to offer)
Level 2	In order to prevent infection, face-to-face classes in the classroom and online classes will be used together. (Students will be asked to come every other week in order to avoi d the 3 Cs in the classroom) In exceptional cases, full face-to-face classes or full online classes may be acceptable depending on the class subject
Level 2. 5	In principle, online classes are conducted
Level 3	All classes are taught online only

2. Faculty / Research Activities

Level 0	As usual
Level 1	 Continuation of research activities under infection control measures (encouraging rese arch activities at home) Appointments to meet with students Refrain from holding lectures or seminars with a large number of people (generally spe aking, more than 10 people)
Level 2	 Continuation of minimal research activities on campus (home-based research activities are encouraged) In principle, online classes are held, but meetings convened by the university, and ot her activities may be held on campus as needed

Level 3	- In principle, teachers are not allowed on campus
	- Refrain from entering the campus except for remote classes and meetings called by the u niversity

3. Office Administration

Level 0	As usual
Level 1	Work as usual, taking care to prevent the spread of infection. Work will be performed fr om home according to the work content
Level 2	 Telecommuting and staggered work hours are encouraged Work assignments will be made under the direction of the supervisor, and if telecommut ing is possible, work will be performed from home
Level 3	Only employees who are necessary to maintain the functioning of the university are expec ted to be present in the workplace. The others are encouraged to work from home if poss ible

4. Meetings

Level O	As usual
Level 1	Continue online meetings in principle. Face-to-face meetings are possible with infection prevention measures, if necessary
Level 2	 Meetings of 10 or more people, including official committee and department meetings, a re done online In order to maintain confidentiality of information not possible with online meetings, face-to-face meetings are only allowed when the university president specifically approves it
Level 3	 In principle, online meetings only In order to maintain confidentiality of information not possible with online meetings, face-to-face meetings are only allowed when the university president specifically approves it

5. Student campus access

Le 0	vel	As usual

Level 1	- Removal of campus entry restriction - Permission to use the library / access point and to enter campus for self-study purpose s, subject to infection control measures (no application for permission required)
Level 2	 In principle, campus entry is not allowed However, special events planned by the university (such as qualification exams) are perm itted Graduate students and fourth-year students may use the library only Library use is limited to 2 hours with permission from the faculty member in charge Some access points are available
Level 3	 All undergraduate, graduate students, and international students are prohibited from cam pus entry However, with special permission from the university, you may enter the university (in t his case, the university will notify you via the portal system). Access points are not available. Note: Access point means designated locations for students without internet access where t hey can use the on-campus Wi-Fi and computers such as Communication Plaza and designated c omputer classrooms (under consideration)

6. Extracurricular activities

Level O	As usual
Level 1	- With maximum consideration for infection prevention measures
Level 2	- No indoor gatherings on or off campus - Some extracurricular activities are allowed depending on the type of activity
Level 3	Total suspension of all activities
