The 2023 English Study and Work Experience Programme

The most important thing I learned in this programme was what I learned about customer service overseas during my internship. At the beginning of my internship, I did simple tasks such as checking expiration dates, taking out items, arranging shelves, clearing the shop and cleaning coffee makers. However, after some time, I was entrusted with the cash register. At first, I was scared of serving customers and handling money on my own. However, people around me in the shop were warm and friendly and taught me everything kindly from the beginning. Dealing with customers who came to buy cigarettes and lottery tickets was so difficult for me at the beginning. However, I was allowed to take pictures of the products, and I looked at those pictures at home so that I could remember the names and locations of the products. At first, I had to call for help very often, but as I got used to it, I became able to do it by myself, and the number of times I had to call for help decreased.

The most special memory of this programme is that I met my wonderful host family in Ireland. They are 4 people in the family: the host mother, the host father, their son who is 14 years old, and their daughter who is 5 years old. There was also a little dog. Their warmth, kindness, and inclusive attitude made me feel like a part of their family. My host mother and father cooked delicious meals for me every day. They talked to me a lot and were very kind and caring. There were a 14-year-old boy and a 5-year-old girl, so in our free time we enjoyed playing football and basketball, drawing, and watching TV and movies together. They are very cute, and I really enjoyed spending time with them. For Halloween and Christmas seasons, we decorated the whole house and the garden together. It is not common to decorate the whole house and the garden in Japan, so it was a fresh experience for me, and I was very happy. Although we could not spend Christmas together, they gave me a nice Christmas gift and a heartfelt farewell message card on the last day. It was a great surprise for me, and I was really happy. Even after I came back to Japan, we still keep in touch with each other via message apps. They sent me messages when I arrived in Japan and on such occasions as Christmas and the New Year. Thanks to them, I was able to know and understand the local life in Ireland. Although there were cultural differences, they welcomed me happily and we were able to understand each other and enjoy spending time together. Talking a lot and sharing wonderful time with them created special and unforgettable memories for me.

I could achieve most of my goals in this program. At my internship site, I was able to learn polite greetings and other language used when serving customers. I also learned the importance of communication. By greeting people with a smile, actively engaging in conversation, and asking questions, I was able to learn the importance of communication. If there were things that I did not understand or wanted to know, I was able to ask people around me actively, such as my college teachers, host family, and people at my internship shop. As a result, I am glad that I was able to build a good

relationship with people at my college and internship shop. I was enriched by this kind of communication not only at my internship shop, but also in conversations with my host family and classmates.

We felt that it was unfair, so I think it would be better to make the total hours of internship the same. Standardizing the internship hours would provide a fairer experience, ensuring equal opportunities for skill development.
